



#### Submission deadline:

Friday, December 15, 2017 at 5pm

#### Entry guidelines:

- All students who live within Dublin City Schools attendance boundaries or who have attended a Dublin Arts Council class or camp within the previous 12 months may submit artworks for consideration. All artwork must be the original work of the artist.
- A student may submit up to three works of art in any medium(s).
- Artworks must be submitted ready for professional exhibition. Two-dimensional artworks, such as paintings and drawings, **must be matted and ready to hang** (hardware attached to back of mat) if they are not framed.
- Artworks that exceed reasonable space requirements may not be accepted for the exhibition.
- Submitted artworks will be reviewed by a juror. Artists/families will be notified of space or content concerns for any artwork that may not be selected. Otherwise, all submitted artwork will be included in the exhibition.

#### Entry fees:

An entry fee of \$7 must accompany each artwork. Artists may submit up to three individual artworks in any medium.

#### Awards:

Best of Show will be awarded in the following categories:

- grades K-2: \$40 cash award
- grades 3-5: \$50 cash award
- grades 6-8: \$60 cash award
- grades 9-12: \$70 cash award
- DCS POWER Plus: \$70 cash award

A juror will determine the Best of Show in each category prior to the exhibition opening.

#### How to enter:

- Submit the lower portion of this application to DAC, signed by both the student artist and parent/legal guardian, with the submission fee. Attach the lower right portion to the back of each artwork. This application may be photocopied.
- Artwork must be received at Dublin Arts Council by 5pm on Friday, December 15, 2017.
- Select the category that reflects the student's grade level when creating the work.
- All artwork remains the property of the artist.
- Artwork accepted for the exhibition must remain at Dublin Arts Council until the end of the exhibition. Artwork will be available for pick up beginning Tues., March 6, 2018 during DAC's regular hours, Tues, 10am-7pm, Wed.-Fri 10am-5pm and Sat. 11am-2pm. Artwork not picked up by May 1, 2018 becomes the property of Dublin Arts Council and may be discarded.

#### Additional information:

Students wishing to sell their artwork during this exhibition may do so. Student artists determine the retail selling price and agree to provide a 20 percent commission to Dublin Arts Council, which will be deducted from the price, if sold. DAC will handle the transaction for the artist.
