Completed entry form and digital artwork image(s) must be submitted to programmgr@dublinarts.org using the subject line ARTifacts by Tuesday, Feb. 9, 2021 at 3pm.

Project description:

The pandemic has disrupted nearly every aspect of our lives: the way we work, communicate, and stay connected. In light of this disruption, Dublin Arts Council will present a retrospective of a two-year Art & Wellness initiative that recognizes the challenges we have all confronted and celebrates the creativity that has flourished. Community members are invited to submit artworks created during the pandemic. Selected submissions will be featured in an exhibition to celebrate the community’s resiliency and creativity during this unprecedented time.

Project timeline:

- Thursday, 1/14/21 – Submission opens at 10am
- Tuesday, 2/9/21 – Submission closes at 3pm
- Friday, 2/19/21 – Artist notified of acceptance
- Week of 2/22/21 – Artwork drop-offs accepted
- Tuesday, 3/9/21 – Exhibition opens
- Friday, 4/16/21 – Exhibition closes
- Tuesday, 4/20/21 – Artists contacted to schedule artwork pick-ups

Entry guidelines:

- Those who live, work, visit, play and learn in Dublin may submit digital artwork image(s) for consideration. All artworks must be the original work of the artist.
- Digital image(s) of up to three works of art in any medium(s) may be submitted.
- Submitted digital artwork image(s) will be reviewed by curators. Artist will be notified of acceptance.

- If accepted, physical artwork must be submitted ready for professional exhibition. Two-dimensional artworks, such as paintings and drawings, must be matted and ready to hang (hardware attached to back of mat) if they are not framed.
- Artworks that exceed reasonable space requirements may not be accepted.
- **No entry fees.**

How to enter:

- Complete the lower portion of this application. Scan it, photograph it or include the information in the body of your email.
- Take a photograph of your artwork.
- Submit your application information and artwork image to programmgr@dublinarts.org using the subject line ARTifacts by Tuesday, Feb. 9, 2021 at 3pm.
- Artists with selected work will be notified by Friday, Feb. 19, 2021.
- If selected, artwork must be received by Dublin Arts Council by Friday, Feb. 26, 2021. Staff will schedule a drop-off time accordingly.
- All artwork remains the property of the artist.
- Artwork accepted for the exhibition must remain at Dublin Arts Council (DAC) until the end of the exhibition, April 16, 2021. Artwork will be available for pick up beginning Tuesday, April 20, 2021 during DAC’s regular business hours. Artwork not picked up becomes the property of DAC and may be discarded.

NOTE:

The exhibition opens to the public with limited capacity, by appointment on March 9, 2021 and closes April 16, 2021. Gallery viewing is subject to change in response to COVID-19. An outdoor exhibition component will be available to a larger audience.
